

2 Notices to Competitors and Signals Made Ashore

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at the Burgee Bar, located along the North side of RYC.

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the main flagpole located North of the Rochester Yacht Club Clubhouse. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after flag AP is lowered. This modifies RRS Race Signals.

3 Courses and Marks



Spinnaker Course: Windward Leeward twice around, with an offset mark. The Leeward mark will be set to windward of the Start-Finish Line. This course will be designated 4W.

Course G is triangle windward finish to leeward. The race committee may designate course G triangle windward leeward finish to leeward.

JAM Course: JAM Course will be a triangle, with marks left to port, with the start finish line ½ way up the windward leg and designated T1 for once around and T2 for twice around.

All marks will be Yellow, Orange, or Green, Tetrahedrons or Cylinders.

4 Time Limits

The time limit for each race will be 90 minutes for the first boat to finish. Time to the first mark is 30 minutes. Finishing limit is 30 minutes after the first boat finishes.

5 Protests

5.1 Protests shall be delivered to the race office within 1 hour after the race committee finish boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon

as practicable after the race in {place}.

- 5.2 Forms available in the RYC bar.
- 5.3 Protests will be heard in RYC club house.

6 Class Flags

The division flags displayed at the warning will correspond to the division that each boat is racing in are found in Race Signals.

7 Scoring

7.1 Three races are scheduled for each division. One race constitutes a series.

7.2 PHRF-LO Time on Time corrections will be used. For Division Scoring, all scores will count. This modifies RRS A2.

7.3 Results will be posted on the Sunset House website. www.sunsethouse.info

7.4 For Overall Scoring, all scores will count. Using the low point system in RRS Appendix A, each boat will be assigned an overall finish place in each race, determined by its corrected time relative to all other boats in the fleet. If boats have identical corrected times in a race, boats will be scored in accordance with RRS A7. After combining the points assigned in all races, the boat with the lowest number of points will be the overall fleet winner. Ties in overall scoring will be broken in accordance with RRS A8.

8 Radio Communication

The race committee will endeavor to broadcast information about the course, headings, and times during the pre-start of each race. Failure to hear radio announcements shall not be cause for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a). The Spinnaker Course shall monitor VHF channel 69. The JAM Course shall monitor VHF Channel 72.
