THE LIPTON CUP

Is being offered for competition for the first time in a series of races to be held by the Rochester Yacht Club, off the Port of Rochester, on Lake Ontario, July 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 1925.

This series of races is open to all Class R Yachts on Lake Ontario regularly enrolled in the Clubs of the Lake Yacht Racing Association.

There will be three races—two triangular, three miles to the leg, twice around (18 statute miles) and one windward or leeward and return, four miles to the leg, twice around (16 statute miles). The Judges will decide on which day the windward and leeward races will be sailed.

The determination of the winner of the LIPTON TROPHY will be by the point system as follows:—

One point for each boat covering the course.

One point for each boat beaten.

The sum of the points scored by each boat in the three races will be her standing for the series.

The boat scoring the greatest number of points will be declared the winner.

In case of two or more boats scoring the same number of points, the Judges will declare a tie and will direct a sail off at such time as they may select.

The number of boats starting in the first race shall be considered the number in succeeding races, regardless of boats dropping out of the series.

There will be three Judges. One will be selected by the Clubs on the north shore of the lake belonging to the L. Y. R. A.; one, likewise, selected by the south shore Clubs and one neutral, from another yachting locality, selected by the Rochester Yacht Club.

The races will be sailed under the rules of the Lake Yacht Racing Association and in accordance with the Deed of Gift of the Trophy.

In addition to the LIPTON TROPHY, there will be three cash prizes. The winner will receive \$100.00, second \$75.00 and third \$50.00. The winner will also receive a Championship Flag with the inscription LIPTON CHAMPION 1925.

A measurement certificate must be filed with the Committee before a yacht will be eligible to start.

The races will be started in the morning on each of the scheduled dates as follows:

Any race not finished before six o'clock P. M. shall be declared off and shall be sailed over.

Chart of the course and other special details will be supplied all contestants by the Committee in charge at Rochester before the first race.

Standard Eastern Time will be used for all events.
