DIV. I—Miscellaneous and unclassified craft may race any race day under Royal Ocean Racing Rule ratings or special handicap.

DIV. II—6 Metre—June Series: (1st 5 races count). June 5, 6, 12, 13, 19, 20, 26, 27.

Saturday Series: (1st 5 races count). July 3, 10, 17, 24; August 14, 21, 28.

Championship Series: (1st 7 races count). July 4, 11, 18, 25; August 15, 22, 29; September 5, 12.

DIV. III—Star—Saturday Series: May 29 to August 28, inclusive.

Sunday Series: May 30 to August 29 inclusive.

World Champion Elimination Series: Six of the Sunday races, June 20 to July 25 inclusive.

DIV. IV—Int. 14—Dr. Baker Series: May 30; June 6, 13, 20, 27; July 4, 11.

Field Championship Series: July 18, 25; August 1, 8, 15, 22, 29; September 5.

STARTING SYSTEM

International Code Flag Signals Hoisted at 5 Minute Intervals for 4 Minutes and 30 Seconds.

W	Warning
P with 1	Preparatory Div. I
P with 2	Preparatory Div. II Start Div. I.
P with 3	Preparatory Div. III Start Div. II.
P with 4	Preparatory Div. IV Start Div. III.
P with 5	Preparatory Div. V Start Div. IV.
R	Recall. 2 shots fired and number called.

A gun calls attention to above Signals. In case of mis-fire the Signals prevail.

COURSES

Course numbers displayed with Warning Signal. Letter "T" for triangular; "W" for windward and leeward; "B" for Bermudian.

See Course Card for compass directions and code flags. Sail 2 rounds unless otherwise notified.

Should permanent outside marks be necessary, races may start and finish in the river just north of the club. Marks will be set as per course 13 with buoys to starboard, and per course 24 with buoys to port.

RULES

N. A. Y. R. U. Rules prevail. A special club rule in effect: "Each boat shall be disqualified which fails to cross starting line before starting time of next class." Attention is also called to the limitation rule on non-members.

Time limits: 3 hours from starting signal for each class.

Signals: 10:30 A. M. and 2:00 P. M.
