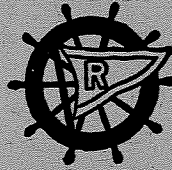

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All races are sailed under NORTH AMERICAN YACHT RACING UNION RULES.
- Handicaps are based on the Royal Ocean Racing Rule as modified by the Lake Yacht Racing Association.
- All series of races are scored on a basis of one point for finishing plus one point for each boat beaten in each race, except in the International Star Class in which a percentage system is used as noted in the class schedule.
- Any special class rules must be approved by the Sailing Committee and filed with the Race Committee.
- Regular crew members of boats participating in Class Races shall be members of the Rochester Yacht Club.
- Starting signals for class races shall be as follows:

Sunday Races .....	10:30 A.M.
Christy Series .....	10:00 A.M.
- The Madge Cup is awarded at the close of the season to the Skipper who has made the best record of the season in scheduled club races or cruises.
