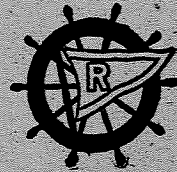

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All races are sailed under 1949 NORTH AMERICAN YACHT RACING UNION rules.
- Handicaps are based on the ~~Royal Ocean Racing~~ *Cruising Club of America's Racing Rules* Rule as modified by the Lake Yacht Racing Association, 1930.
- All series of races are scored on a basis of one point for finishing plus one point for each boat beaten in each race, except in the International Star Class in which a percentage system is used as noted in the class schedule.
- Any special class rules must be approved by the Sailing Committee and filed with the Race Committee.
- Regular crew members of boats participating in Class Races shall be members of the Rochester Yacht Club.
- Starting signals for Class Races shall be as follows:

Saturday Races 2:00 P. M.

Sunday Races 10:30 A. M.

Christy Series 10:00 A. M.

- The Madge Cup is awarded at the close of the season to the skipper who has made the best record of the season in scheduled club races or cruises.
- The Clifton H. Baker Memorial Trophy is awarded annually to a skipper or a crewman under twenty-five years of age, who displays the greatest improvement in sailing ability, seamanship, and sportsmanship during the season.
