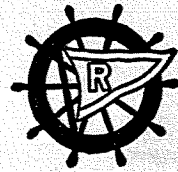

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All races are sailed under 1949 NORTH AMERICAN YACHT RACING UNION rules.
- Handicaps are based on the Cruising Club of America Racing Rule as modified by the Lake Yacht Racing Association, 1950.
- All series of races are scored on a basis of one point for finishing plus one point for each boat beaten in each race, except in the International Star Class in which a percentage system is used as noted in the class schedule.
- Any special class rules must be approved by the Sailing Committee and filed with the Race Committee.
- Regular crew members of boats participating in Class Races shall be members of the Rochester Yacht Club, or of the immediate family of any member.
- Starting signals for Class Races shall be as follows:

Saturday Races..... 2:00 P.M.  
 Sunday Races..... 10:30 A.M.  
 Christy Series..... 10:00 A.M.

- The Madge Cup is awarded at the close of the season to the skipper who has made the best record of the season in scheduled club races or cruises.
- The Clifton H. Baker Memorial Trophy is awarded annually to a skipper or a crewman under twenty-five years of age, who displays the greatest improvement in sailing ability, seamanship, and sportsmanship during the season.

PRE-FREEMAN—July 21, 6:00 P.M., Rochester to Youngstown

Eligible—Any sailing yacht registered in the Rochester Yacht Club—sailing to participate in the Freeman or Louise Freeman races.

FREEMAN CUP—July 23, Youngstown to Chaumont Bay.

L.Y.R.A. Regatta—Course Racing—Crescent Yacht Club—Chaumont Bay  
July 26, 27, 28.

ROCHESTER RACE—Aug. 20, 2:00 P.M.

Longest fresh water race, 335 miles.
