

# Rogue And Gardenia In Close Finish For Freeman Cup

## Rogue Beats Kathea And Nayada Handily; Result Up To Judges

Time Allowance of About Three Hours and Two Minutes Given Rogue Over Gardenia, 75-Foot Cutter of Royal Canadian Yacht Club, Makes Finish in Some Doubt—Power Yacht Rams Sloop.
