We have lost our unique role of having two club champions in one fleet. This was learned at the annual meeting of the Rochester Yacht Club, wherein the seasons results were acclaimed and the prizes awarded. Farley insists on a correction to the article appearing in last months "Starlight" wherein we acclaimed our unique co-champions. The Club Championship Series was the last scheduled series on our calendar and even this series was postponed because of the Six meter championship being held at the Rochester Yacht Club - this made our series unusually late. It seems that the co-champions met on the waters of Lake Ontario one indeterminate week day night without the knowledge of the Star Fleet or of the Racing committee of the Club. According to our best knowledge a course was set by a member of the yard crew of the club a starting gun was fired and the contestants left to their fate. The race was finished in darkness. At our annual meeting Clifton H. Baker was elected Fleet Captain and J.A. McConnell was reelected Secretary for 1941. A committee headed by S. Farnham was appointed to codify the rules of the Star Fleet and the Rochester Yacht Club in order that the legal entanglements be minimized for the benefit of newcomers. It was decided to hold the 12th District Regatta again at the Rochester Yacht Club sometime in August and plans were formulated whereby the 1941 Regatta will outdo even the successful Regatta of 1940.
