Dear sir,

We are very happy to hear of your application to the International Star Class and bid you a hearty welcome into an enthusiastic class.

I apologize for the lateness of this reply but before replying to your letter it was necessary to call a meeting of the fleet, which is difficult during the sailing season.

We herewith grant your fleet the territory as included on the American side of Lake Ontario west of the Westerly line of Oneida county, state of New York.

To avoid any difficulty for naming future fleets, particularly at Hamilton or at Youngstown, we suggest that you add "American" to your suggested name thereby making your fleet name "Eastern Lake Ontario American".

Upon the receipt of your charter your fleet becomes eligible to compete in the Central New York Regatta and the Twelfth District Regatta. The Central New York Regatta, sponsored by the Keuka Lake Yacht Club, is to be held at Keuka Lake on August ¹⁴~~21~~, ¹⁵~~22~~, and ¹⁶~~23~~, 1941.
