

## Yacht Club May Fit Two Boats For Fisher Cup

A general meeting of the members of the Rochester Yacht club will take place next Saturday for two purposes. One is to make changes in the constitution and the by-laws and the other relates to fitting out Class P yachts for the Fisher Cup challenge.

Commodore Thomas Parsons has sent notices to members in which he makes the following explanation:

"This meeting is doubly important as there is another subject coming up which should be considered by our entire active membership. This is in regard to the fitting out of the Olympian, as well as the Alloede, for a series of trial races for the purpose of selecting the fastest P Class yacht available to back up our challenge for the Fisher Cup. The opinion has been expressed by some that the Olympian should be fitted out as a trial horse for the Alloede and it is also quite possible that she might prove the faster boat and, if so, should be selected as the actual challenger."
