THE Lake Ontario (American) FLEET FOR THE MONTH OF May 1938

Harold Bills who tended jib sheets on Commodore Harold Field's "Starlet" last season will skipper the boat in the coming campaign. Bills has had considerable experience in small boats and should furnish some real competition.

With hostilities scheduled to start tomorrow, all boats were in the water this morning. The fleet looked in splendid condition and showed results of careful and efficient fitting out. Peck Farley's "Deuse" looked particularly fine with white topsides, varnished deck, and black rail. The varnished deck on Earl Snyder's "Valkyr II" has materially improved his boat. Fleet Captain Oscar Marth's "Tario", as usual, was in the W-I pink.
